David Cronenberg's compelling movie about the triangular relationship between Sabina Spielrein, Carl Jung and Sigmund Freud opens a Pandora's box of issues in depth psychology concerning relationships between women and men, and patients and analysts. The film is set in the early days of the psychoanalytic movement – the first faltering steps in a new approach to psychological healing. The central theme of the film is Jung's complex relationship with his patient Sabina Spielrein – one which raises controversial questions about the relationship between analysts and patients
